



# Bunny Hat

**Size:** Baby 6-12 months, with changes for **Toddler**, and **Child/Teen** sizes

**Materials needed:** Approx. 4 oz. worsted weight yarn in White, and small amounts of Pink and Black. Size J crochet hook, or size needed to obtain gauge: 3 dc = 1" and 2 dc rows = 1" Yarn needle.

**Abbreviations:** beg=beginning ch=chain dc=double crochet ea=each hk=hook rep=repeat sc=single crochet sk=skip sl st=slip stitch

**Notes:** Ch 2 at beg of ea row does not count as a dc. Do not turn at end of rows. The dc you join in at the end of each round will be the first dc of the next round. Be sure to check your gauge - I crochet loosely.

## All sizes:

Row 1: Ch 4, sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> ch to form a ring, ch 2, work 12 dc in ring, join with sl st in top of 1<sup>st</sup> dc, ch 2.

Row 2: Work 2 dc in ea dc, join with sl st in top of 1<sup>st</sup> dc, ch 2. (24 dc)

Row 3: \* Dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, rep from \*, join, ch 2. (36 dc)

Row 4: \* 2 dc in next dc, dc in ea of next 2 dc, rep from \*, join, ch 2. (48 dc)

## Baby size only:

Rows 5 thru 11: Dc in ea dc, join, ch 2. (48 dc) At end of Row 11, ch 1.

Row: 12: Sc in ea dc, join, finish off.

## Toddler and Child/Teen sizes: (Child/Teen size in parentheses)

Row 6: \* Dc in ea of next 7 (3) dc, 2 dc in next dc, rep from \*, join, ch 2. [54, (60) dc]

Rows 7 thru 13 (15): Dc in ea dc, join, ch 2. [54, (60) dc]

Row 14 (16): Sc in ea dc, join, fasten off.

## Ears: Make four, 2 white and 2 pink Leave a long tail at beg of ea white piece, for sewing ears to hat later.

Row 1: Ch 9 (10, 11), dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hk and in ea ch across, ch 2, turn. [7 (8, 9) dc]

Rows 2 thru 9 (11, 13): Dc in ea dc, ch 2, turn.

Row 10 (12, 14): Dec over 1<sup>st</sup> two dc, dc in ea dc to within last 2 dc, dec over last 2 dc, ch 2, turn.

Row 11 (13, 15): Dec over 1<sup>st</sup> two dc, dc in ea dc to within last 2 dc, dec over last 2 dc, finish off, leaving extra long tail for sewing ear pieces together. Pull end of yarn tail thru last lp worked to secure. Thread yarn tail onto yarn needle. Sew one white piece to one pink piece, whip-stitching all the way around edge of ear. Refer to photo for placement and sew ears to hat, having pink side in and white side facing outwards. With Black yarn and yarn needle, embroider eyes with satin stitch, and whiskers with long running stitches. Embroider nose with Pink, using satin stitch

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
