

Simple Dishcloth

A simple pattern that is quick to knit!

Supplies

Yarn: 95 yds worsted weight cotton

Needles: US size 7 or 8

Notions: tapestry needle, row counter (optional)

Gauge: Not crucial. Knit at a gauge that give you the kind of fabric you like.

CO 3 sts

Row 1: Knit across

Row 2: K1, Kfb, K1 (4 sts)

Row 3: K2, YO, K2 (5 sts)

Row 4 and all EVEN numbered rows: Knit across

Row 5: K2, YO, K1, YO, K2 (7 sts)

Row 7: K2, YO, knit across to last 2 sts, YO, K2

Rows 9-43: Repeat rows 7 & 8 until you have 45 sts on your needle

Row 45: K1, ssk, YO, ssk, knit to last 5 sts, K2tog, YO, K2tog, K1

Rows 47-80: Repeat rows 45 & 46 until you have 9 sts on your needle

Row 81: K1, ssk, YO, s1k2pssso, YO, K2tog, K1 (7 sts)

Row 83: K1, ssk, YO, s1k2pssso, K1 (5 sts)

Row 85: K1, sl1k2pssso, K1 (3 sts)

Bind off 3 remaining stitches & weave in ends.

You are welcome to share this pattern with family and friends. Please do not use commercially.

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Abbreviations

BO	bind off
CO	cast on
K	knit
K2tog	knit the next 2 sts together as one
P	purl
Ssk	slip 1 st as if to knit, slip the next st as if to knit, insert left needle into the front of these 2 sts and knit them together
S1k1pssso	Slip 1 st, knit the next 2 together, pass the slipped st over
St(s)	stitch(es)
